Jason St Juste signs for Sandnes



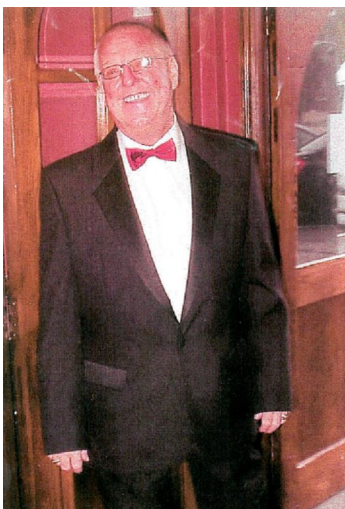
Garforth winger Jason St Juste has joined Norwegian side Sandnes ULF for an undisclosed fee.
